

ORDINANCE NO. 210

ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE V, HUMAN DEVELOPMENT, CHAPTER 1, LIBRARY SERVICES

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Scranton, Iowa, as follows:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE. The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Scranton, Iowa, 2014, to provide for a change in the makeup of the Library Board of Trustees according to the proposed change as provided in Resolution # 2015-20, passed and approved by the City Council on September 8, 2015, and passed by electors of the City in the regular city election held on November 3, 2015. This Ordinance amendment also allows for a change in the name of the library by adding a "doing business as" to the name of the library.

SECTION 2: AMENDMENT TO CURRENT SECTIONS.

Title V, Chapter 1, Sections 5-1-1, 5-1-2 and 5-1-4(1) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Scranton are hereby amended to read as follows:

5-1-1 PUBLIC LIBRARY. There is hereby established a free public library for the City, to be known as the Scranton Public Library, doing business as the "H.F. and Maude E. Marchant Memorial Library".

5-1-2 LIBRARY TRUSTEES: The Board of Trustees of the Scranton Public Library, hereinafter referred to as the Board, consists of five (5) members. The Mayor shall appoint all board members, subject to the approval of the City Council.

5-1-4(1) Terms of Office: All appointments to the Board shall be for three (3) years, except to fill vacancies. Each term shall commence on July first. One-third of the total number of Board members, or as near as possible, shall be appointed every year for the purpose of staggering terms.

SECTION 3: REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.


SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
