## **CHAPTER 14 FISHING REGULATIONS**

3-14-1 Adoption of Iowa Fishing Regulations 3-14-3 Minimum Length - Bass3-14-2 Violation

**3-13-1** Adoption of Iowa fishing regulations. Any person who shall fail to abide by the provisions of this chapter and the applicable provisions of this chapter and the applicable provisions of the following Iowa statutory laws relating to fishing and angling is in violation of this chapter. These sections of the code are adopted by reference:

1. 109.1, 109.2, 109.3, 109.11, 109.12, 109.13, 109.23, 109.30, 109.32, 109.37, 109.38, 109.44, 109.47, 109.63, 109.64, 109.67, 109.71, 109.72, 109.73, 109.74, 109.76, 109.78, 109.80, 109.82.

**3-13-2 VIOLATION.** Any person who shall fail to abide by the provisions of the regulations established by the Iowa Department of Natural Resources is in violation of this chapter.

**3-13-3 MINIMUM LENGTH - BASS.** The minimum length shall apply to all black bass including largemouth, smallmouth, and spotted bass. Any bass less than 16" must be immediately released from which they were caught.
