CHAPTER 7 SATELLITE DISHES

6-7-1 Location of Satellite Dishes 6-7-2 Permit, Fee

6-7-1 LOCATION OF SATELLITE DISHES. The City of Scranton shall prohibit the construction of any satellite disc or dishes over 30 inches in diameter within the city limits of the City of Scranton which are in any residential area. Satellite discs or dishes may be maintained in commercial areas.

6-7-2 PERMIT, FEE. Any satellite receiving dish or disc for the purpose of receiving communication signals exceeding thirty-six (36) inches in diameter may be placed in a commercial area after a permit granted by the building inspector of the city and only upon compliance of the following:

a. Any such disc or dish placed on the ground shall be permanently anchored to a concrete foundation, which shall extend under the ground 42 inches or more.

b. Any disc placed on a building shall first have a certification from a licensed engineer that said building or structure is able to hold said disc and both the disc and structure are capable of withstanding wind and weather stress.

c. Any person desiring to install a satellite disc or dish shall first submit to the City Building Inspector a plot or plan showing the size of the proposed structure, its location in relation to other structures and the size and lot lines of the property on which the structure is proposed to be built and shall pay a permit fee in the amount of \$15.00.
